CLARK'S CORNER

It's hard to believe but we will be in our fourth week of eggs by the time you receive this newsletter. What's also hard to fathom is that we are fast approaching Holy Week and Easter. I have a new and exciting opportunity for you during Holy Week. On Monday night, March 29th at 6:30 pm. Beit Hallel, Jewish Christian Church in Kernersville, and First Presbyterian will hold a joint Seder Meal in our Fellowship Hall.

I know the leaders of Beit Hallel well through my participation with the Ministerial Association Mike, Kevin and Bonnie are well versed in the Old Testament and the relationship of the Old Testament to the New Testament. They read Hebrew fluently, are excited to help lead us through an authentic Seder Meal and believe in Jesus or Yeshua as their Lord and Messiah. You are in for a real treat!

A Seder Meal is eaten in celebration of the Passover. The Jewish Passover commemorates the time in Israel's history when God spared or "passed over" the people of Israel while in captivity in Egypt and saved their first born sons from death. However the eldest sons of Egypt all died as a result of God's judgment upon the Egyptians for not allowing Israel to go free. It was during the celebration of Passover that Jesus

celebrated his last supper with the disciples and was betrayed, arrested and crucified.

This very special meal helps us to reenact the time of the Passover and enables us to better understand God's love, protection and mercy. It will be jointly led by me and a leader from Beit Hallel.

As a church we are responsible for providing the meal which follows the service. Chicken, two vegetables and salad are to be provided by us. **There is to be no pork such as ham in the vegetables and no bread products.** Beit Hallel will provide the dessert and everything needed for the Seder Meal. Please plan on 2 to 2 1/2 hours for the Seder Meal and the Fellowship Dinner that follows. This is a celebration for the entire family. So bring the kids. The Outreach and Worship Committees will be working together to plan the fellowship meal. **Reservations are required.** Please contact Jane Dull by calling her at 993-7358 to let us know if you are planning on attending.

In addition to the Seder Meal on Monday, March 29, we will also hold our **traditional Tenebrae Service on Thursday, April 1 at 7:30 pm in the sanctuary.** Once again we will need readers to read scripture for this service. Please let Jane or me know

if you are willing to read for the Tenebrae Service.

I am also assuming that Bunker Hill Methodist Church will lead the community in the **Annual Cross Walk observance on Good Friday from the North Main Food Lion.** If you have not participated in this walk, you have missed out on a very special event. For those who can't walk the entire route, a van will be available on the route to pick you up and take you to the gazebo at Mt. Gur cemetery where the walk ends or back to Food Lion.

The week would not be complete without **celebrating the resurrection of Christ. Easter Service will be held Sunday, April 4 at 10:30 am.**

There's a lot going on this time of year. In addition to what has already been mentioned, we continue with Financial Peace University, Disciples Bible Study, Eggs, Kids in Christ, Wednesday Youth Nights, Men's Group and planning for the Intergenerational Mission Trip this summer. Thanks for all that you do in supporting the work of Christ here at First Presbyterian!
